SYNOPSIS

Set on Christmas Eve, FILTHY ANIMALS tells the story of two misfit outlaws, Lars, a thrill-seeking drug enthusiast, and Freddy, a bodybuilder recently out of rehab, who hunt down child sexual predators.

FILTHY ANIMALS DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT

My first feature, Filthy Animals, is a beautiful and amazing collaboration of talented people I had the honor of bringing together and leading over the last five years. From day one, I had a mission to make a feature film, and what a privilege it is to say we completed it. I can confidently say that I used every single connection and resource that I had to complete the film. To maximize any resources available to me, I wrote the script based on specific locations I had access to and actors I knew could be a part of the project even on a low-budget independent film.

Regarding the genesis of the story itself, one of my lifelong best friends was sexually abused when he was a child. When I wrote the script, I told my friend that although I couldn't get justice for him against his actual perpetrator, I could hunt the sexual predators in our movie. I grew up with a lot of peculiar characters around me and with a young single mom, I was often thrust into unusual environments. For example, my stepmom was a kleptomaniac and stole from the Girl Scout cookies. To make things even more unusual, in one bizarre incident, my stepmom beat herself up in a bathroom and blamed someone else for it. Coming from a cinematic background, I had always imagined what that would have looked like in a movie. How would someone get to the point of hurting themselves and carrying those vices with them? But then I started thinking that perhaps, aren't we all flawed in some way? Filthy Animals is a character-driven film, but it is also an exercise in that we all have a vice. We are all "filthy animals" in some way, but obviously, the sexual predators are the truly "filthiest animals."

Coming from the world of personal training and never having made a feature film, there was some work to get people to buy into the project. Though we may be considered "independent," I quickly realized there was no such thing as creating a project without collaboration from those I hoped could see the project through. My wife and former film professor and mentor at El Camino College helped develop the script and eventually came on board as producers. Our cinematographer was my former teacher's assistant in my production class at El Camino College. Many of the crew were recent college graduates (not sound though, we made sure to pay for good sound). One of my personal training clients owns a camera shop, so we were able to use his equipment and also some from the college. For editing, I was able to work with a former student of the veteran editor, Larry Jordan, who oversaw the work and guided us through the process. I networked on social media to make as many connections as possible which even led to getting unbelievable discounts for our original score, soundtrack, color, sound, and other vital post-production services.

The two male leads in the film were friends that I've grown up with. One I have kept in touch with through the years and had vocalized an interest in acting, and the other is my best friend who's dealt with addiction much of his life. Though both had no real on-camera experience, I thought that building the story around their unique personalities, experiences and natural chemistry would help

bring these characters to life. Knowing them from such a young age, I was confident that once they were in front of the camera, they would have that same chemistry and charm to bring Lars and Freddy to life.

One afternoon, the actor who plays Freddy was squatting at the gym with five plates on each side. Impressed with his strength, a man approached him on his technique, which got them chatting and later exchanging names and contact info. I later found out this man who approached my friend was actor Raymond J. Barry. Ray is a veteran actor who's appeared in numerous films such as *Training Day, Cool Runnings, Flubber, Born on the Fourth of July, Justified, Dewey Cox, The Purge, Falling Down,* and *Dead Man Walking*. My friend graciously shared his contact info and helped me connect with him.

To be honest, I did not even think it was possible to hire Ray for more than a one-day shoot because of his expected salary as well as how busy and active he was in the industry. Initially the character I approached Ray to play was a minor role but after Ray read the script for the film, he asked if he could be cast in a more prominent role as Lester, one of the main sexual predators in the film. I was truly amazed and humbled that Ray gave us an incredible deal to join the project. From day one, Ray was extremely inspiring for us all. It was clear to us all that the entire cast and crew needed to bring their best each day and match Ray's professionalism.

When you spend five years of your life finishing a project, you want the subject matter being worked on to be personal; to mean something and to possibly be therapeutic to the filmmakers who create it and audiences who watch it. I am extremely grateful for our journey in making this film, for the completed art, and for the film family we built along the way.

RAYMOND J. BARRY - Lester

Raymond J. Barry is a veteran of both screen and stage work. Some of Barry's feature film credits include Born on the Fourth of July, Dead Man Walking, The Purge 3, The Deep End, Brave New Jersey, Walk Hard: the Dewey Cox Story, Training Day, Flubber, The Ref, The Chamber, COP, Falling Down, K-2, Rapid Fire, Cool Runnings, and Sudden Death.

His many television appearances include the series *Justified*, *Cold Case*, *13 Reasons Why*, *Feud!*, *The Gifted*, *Shooter*, *Gotham*, *Ray Donovan*, *You're the Worst*, *Grey's Anatomy*, *The 100*, *ICE*, *New Girl*, *Law and Order*, *Lost*, *CSI*, *Alias*, *The Cleaner*, *The X Files*, *Tales from the Crypt*, and *L.A. Law*. For his role in *Steel City*, he was <u>nominated for an Independent Spirit Award in 2007</u>. For his role in <u>Interview with the Assassin</u>, he received the Best Actor award at the New York International Independent Film Festival in 2002.

In theatre, he began with such legendary companies as the <u>Living Theater</u>, and Joseph Chaikin's <u>Open Theater</u> where he toured around the world, and took part in such creations as The Serpent, Terminal, Mutation Show, Masques, Endgame, and Nightwalk.

He went on to perform in more than eighty productions in New York, from Broadway to Off Broadway, including the Tony nominated musical Happy End by Kurt Weil and Bertolt Brecht. For his work in theatre, he received a Dramalogue Award for his lead performance in Sam Shepard's Buried Child.

He also received a Dramalogue Award and L.A. Drama Critics Award for Writing and Best Actor, for his play <u>Once in Doubt</u>.

He is married to writer Robyn Mundell. Together they have four children, Oona, Raymond, Liam, and Manon.

AUSTAN WHEELER - Lars

Austan Wheeler is known for his villainous role as the dreadful, drunken Health Russell in ID channels' *Betrayed*; season four episode seven. He appeared in the first episode of the *Wild West Chronicles* debut on the INSP channel, where he played the part of Emmitt. Austan's earlier stage work consisted of roles such as Tom Giles in Meredith Wilson's, The Music Man and the role of The Valet in Jean-Paul Sartre's, No Exit. His upcoming break-out role as Lars in James T North IV's film, Filthy Animals, will reveal the next up incoming actor we will all expect great things from. Austan was trained in the Film and Television Department at Point Loma Nazarene University where he also minored in Theater under the teachings of Walter Williams. From there, Austan returned to L.A. to study under the teachings of John Homa and Jeff Dockweiler at JH Productions where he states, "I finally realized what acting was really all about". Austan also starred in roles in other eclectic works such as the staunch, religious father in Scott Alexander Naar's short film, Umbra (2020), as well as his role as the cult leader Joshua in Emily Arendt's short film, Benjamin's Box. His

Spilatro grew up in the New York City suburbs and spent his first 12 years in the industry doing VFX on commercials in the Chicago area, where he'd graduated from Illinois State University with a degree in Film & TV. In addition to his own expertise in an impressive number of VFX packages, he also has an excellent track record building talented and technically advanced teams.
